

**They Call It Puppy Love**  
Fall School 2005

You will need:

Canvas work glove with ribbed cuff  
Small pieces of black and red felt  
10 7mm wiggly eyes  
10 ½" tan pompoms  
5 7mm black pompoms  
1 ½ yd. 1/8" ribbon  
polyester fiberfil  
container (tuna or catfood can) 1 ½" X 3 ½"  
sticky felt 1 ½" X 12"  
tacky glue or glue gun

1. Cut out 10 ears and 5 tongues.
2. Stuff glove fingers firmly and hand lightly with fiberfil.
3. Glue two tan pompoms onto square end of each tongue to form muzzle. Then glue muzzles onto front of fingers.
4. Glue on eyes and noses to finish face.
5. Glue ears to top of fingers.
6. Tie bow snugly around each finger below face.
7. Cover container with sticky felt, keeping felt even with bottom edge of can.
8. Stretch cuff over container, overlapping about 1/3 of the container. Glue in place.
9. Settle puppies into the container. Spot glue to hold in place.
