The Service Unit Cookie Share will give your Service Unit the framework it needs for helping girls discover the real tools for success.

How it Works . . .

- Points are earned by the Service Unit for completing the Cookie Share activities throughout the 2010 Cookie Program.
- The total points earned determines the amount of Cookie Share Bucks received based on the number of boxes sold within the Service Unit.
- Cookie Share may be redeemed by designated Service Unit Team members for services benefiting the **entire Service Unit**.
- Cookie Share points are earned from 7/1/09 to 6/30/10.
- Service Units are responsible for tracking their Cookie Share activities.

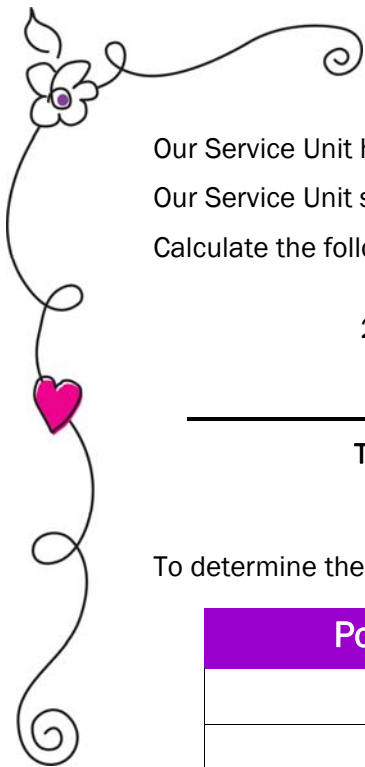

Points Earned	Total Earned Per Box
1 to 30	1.0 ¢
31 to 55	1.5 ¢
56 to 80	2.0 ¢
81 to 110	2.5 ¢
111+	3.0 ¢

Cookie Buck Redemption

- Cookie Share Bucks may be redeemed by designated Service Unit Team members for services benefiting the **entire Service Unit**.
- Cookie Share Bucks may be used for the following; registration for Council Events (*i.e. Annual Council Meeting, SU Kick-off, SU Conference*), purchases in The Bay Shop, and reimbursement for expenses from Service Unit Events.
 - For use in The Bay Shop, submit Cookie Share Bucks when purchasing items.
 - For registration and reimbursements, submit Cookie Share Bucks to the Product Sales Department. It **must include purpose of redemption and supporting documentation** (*copy of request: flyer, contract, receipts, registration/reservation forms*)
- 2009 Cookie Share Bucks may be redeemed from **8/1/2009 to 7/31/2010**
- 2010 Cookie Share Bucks will be received August 2010 and may be redeemed from **8/1/2010 to 7/31/2011**.
