## Teen Member, Board of Directors – Application due: January 13, 2012

10th grade Seniors, 11th grade Ambassadors

What an opportunity for Girl Scouts from across the Council to showcase their leadership skills! Each year, two Girl Scout Seniors or Ambassadors are selected through an interview process to represent the GIRLS in Girl Scouting by serving a one-year term as a non-voting member on the GSCB Board of Directors. Working with the members of the Board is an honor and will open your eyes to the hundreds of decisions the Board makes every year to keep our Council strong and growing.

NOTE: You will need to submit a biography with your application. You will be notified by mid-February 2012 regarding the interview.

## Sudden Opportunities – Application due: October 28, 2011

**SUDDEN LEADERSHIP** – We need teens available to respond on short notice to make public appearances representing Girl Scouts at meetings, award presentations, funding events, etc. May often include interviews or presentations that require speaking before an audience.

**SUDDEN PHOTO** – We need teens available to respond on short notice to unexpected photo opportunities for publications and articles about Girl Scouting.

## Women of Distinction – Application due: December 16, 2011, for all positions.

**GENERAL** – This leadership opportunity may have you assisting as a door greeter, speaker, honoree escort or registration assistant. You must attend our Powerful First Impression Workshop if you are first-time guest at this event.

**FLAG PRESENTER** – Teens are needed to perform the flag ceremony opening the event. We need a minimum of five teens to fill the roles of caller, flag bearers and color guard. Rehearsal will take place February 18, 2012, following the Powerful First Impression Workshop at 3:30 p.m.

**VOCALIST** – Perform during opening and/or closing of the event. Rehearsal will be February 18, 2012, following the Powerful First Impression Workshop at 3:30 p.m.

**INVOCATION** – Read the invocation aloud before dinner. Must be comfortable reading in front of a large audience (around 250 guests) and using a microphone.

**MISTRESS OF CEREMONIES** – Preside over the program from the podium on the dais. Greet guests, open the event, introduce speakers and ensure smooth flow of program. Must be comfortable reading in front of a large audience (around 250 guests) and using a microphone. Auditions for this position will be held January 18, 2012, starting at 6:30 p.m. Location TBD depending on number of applicants. You must also include a biography with your application for this position.
